KORALIK PARAINTEGRACJI (Para)Integrated Weaving Through Beading

The project "(Para)Integrated Weaving Through Beading" was initiated by volunteers from Poland, Italy and Greece who shared their own observations on the mentally handicapped. The volunteers desired to sensitize the society and make them contemplate on overall tendency to discriminate 'otherness'. There are a few types of barriers hampering the commonplace functioning of the disabled in everyday life, i.a: cognitive, motivation, and personality obstacles. The volunteers diagnosed the needs of the disabled and their observations inspired them to create the project proposal.

Young helpers are as well young social assistants as instructors of creative activities who combine two passions: interest in human being and art. Taking care of the mentally handicapped they help, serve them, support, listen carefully, talk, advise, teach and co-feel.

Breaking the prejudice is strictly related to fighting for one's own rights and the possibility of speaking out not exposing the disabled to being publicly mocked at or discriminated.

The project satisfied the diagnosed needs and its implementation contributed to achieving the following goals:

- developing the learning culture
- conducting an intensive international dialogue
- increase of intercultural awareness
- strengthening of solidarity and European cohesion
- protection of freedom and human rights
- popularization of European integration
- combating and preventing social exclusion
- developing participants' passions and interests

The main project result is an album describing and reporting all handmade works of young disabled artists, including mainly bead jewellery and pictures. Each participant also received the Youthpass certificate.

Thanks to the project participants could practise language skills, shape or strengthen the attitude of tolerance, respect for human dignity, socialize with each other, lead an open intercultural dialogue, thus reinforcing European cohesion. The participants could also overcome their internal barriers and limitations.

The form of project dissemination via social media will be a peculiar long-term benefit resulting from the project implementation. Besides, the shaped or enhanced values and the satisfied needs will have a long-term influence on participants because social results that were achieved, mainly remaining in human awareness, can exert a durable influence on the functioning of a young, growing person.


