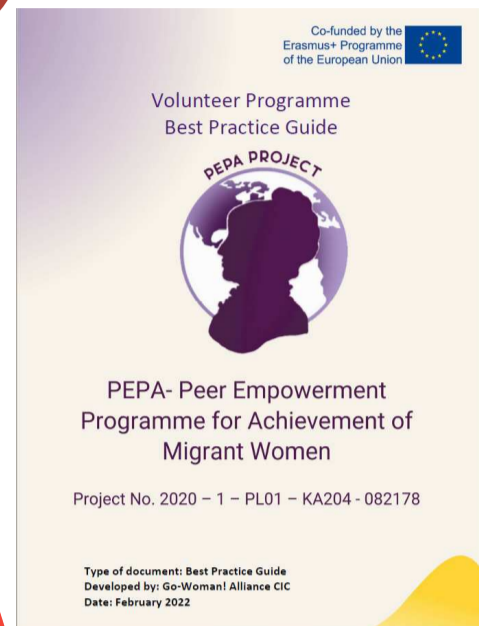

Best Practice guide for practitioners



The final version of our Best Practice guide, aimed at practitioners who could engage and support migrant women in peer support activities, is produced and ready to be use! The guide was tested by over 120 women and organisations. Feedback from testing was incorporated into the final version of the guide and now it's translated to all partner languages:: Polish, Spanish, Romanian, Bulgarian. Peer Support Guide

The partners are still working to produce the Peer Support Guide. Till now we have created lesson plans and collected some real examples and good practices. Now each partner is organising focus groups in their countries. Till the end of April 2022, 180 migrant women will participate in user testing and will guide the formative development of resources. After piloting the resources we will produce the peer support guide, which will be aimed at migrant women to inform and inspire them to deliver quality peer support activities, including language learning, creative activities, and workplace skills.

PEER EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME FOR ACHIEVEMENT OF MIGRANT WOMEN



The partners already developed:

- DIAGNOSTIC TOOL, identifying to which target audience the user belongs, and asking questions about their current situation and aspirations, in order to give relevant advice and to create a tailored learning journey.
- TRAINING MATERIALS for:
 - Organisations working with migrant women, with 'train the trainer' materials to help staff to support and encourage migrant women to deliver peer support;
 - Migrant women themselves, with information about the personal benefits of volunteering and peer support, important considerations when starting to volunteer, and guidance on how to plan and deliver successful peer-support activities.
- LESSON UNITS on areas including: Leadership; Workplace and entrepreneurial skills; Writing a strong CV; Self- and public presentation

Now, 120 women will participate in the user testing. Through their engagement in robust user testing, they will ensure the relevance, quality and user-friendliness of the final resources and will guide the formative development of learning resources.

Transnational project meetings

Two transnational project meetings were held from our last newsletter till April 2022! One in Reus, Spain and one in Birmingham, UK The partners had the opportunity to meet in person and discuss deeply the work done so far, next steps and exchange useful knowledge and experience.
